The beach is the strip of well groomed, clean sand stretching from the harbor entrance north east towards the resorts. Médano Beach is to Cabo what Waikiki is to Honolulu. A place to see, be seen and to meet.



It was easy to find an umbrella covered table at the beach level or one in the covered bar area at 1PM. By 3PM you had to look sharp and move quick to find a table when someone else left.
